The Tipperary Festival of Science comprises of a jam-packed week of inspiring & engaging activities for primary & second level school students.

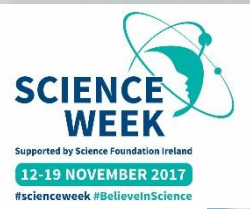
These include interactive Science Shows and inquiry based hands-on workshops:
