John Philip Holland developed the first submarine to be formally commissioned by the U.S. Navy and the first Royal Navy submarine.

Francis Beaufort creator of the Beaufort Scale for indicating wind force.



Ernest Shackleton

whose Antarctic expeditions made many important scientific discoveries. During his 1914 Expedition, Shackleton's ship *The Endurance* was crushed by ice due to bad weather and windy conditions.
